

MINICON 12 ARTSHOW INFORMATION

- A. All art must be at the con artshow room by noon, Friday, April 8th.
- B. All art mailed or shipped to the con must be received before Monday, April 4th. Send all art not brought in person to:

- C. Each items must be accompanied by entry forms and fee. Entry fees are 25 cents per item.
- D. After the con, all art will be held by Jim Odbert at his home until Friday, April 15th. If it is not picked up by that date, it will be shipped COD to the sender.
- E. All items entered will be assumed to be for sale unless clearly marked NFS (Not For Sale).
- F. All art must have a science fiction or fantasy theme. The Artshow Committee reserves the right to refuse any piece it feels does not meet these standards.
- G. There will be three Judges' Awards plus and Award for Best in Show and an Award for Most Popular in Show that will be voted on by the viewing public.

This year, Minicon is going to try something new in determining auction order. As an artist, you are asked to list the order in which you would like to have your items auctioned. Also, please inform the Artshow Committee if you are leaving the con early and want to take your art with you.

As your art comes in, it will be placed in the auction in the order you have listed. At least five other items will be placed between each of your items.

The listing will be posted at the art show. At the auction, all items with two or more bids will be auctioned in the order listed. After all of these have been auctioned, all items with one bid will be auctioned (if time allows). Items which receive no bids will not be auctioned.
